



SANITARY ACCESS CONDITIONS

WEARING A MASK

IS MANDATORY

- **Inside** any establishment.
- **Outside** when the physical distance of 2 metres between two people cannot be respected.

NB. Since the 21st of July, wearing a mask is mandatory in Hérault (as in more and more tourist departments). As soon as you go outside the campsite, masks should be worn outside, notably in towns and villages.

IS NOT MANDATORY

- On the beach.
- Within bathing zones (swimming pools, Balnéo, Waterslides).
- In natural areas (Les Orpellières, hinterland, Nature Reserves).

A HEALTH PASS

IS MANDATORY TO ENTER THE CAMPSITE

- It must be presented once on arrival at the camping for each of the people taking part in the stay who are aged 18 years or over.
- Day visitors included
- After which it will no longer be necessary to present it at the campsite to:
 - Enjoy the swimming pools .
 - Join in the entertainment and shows.
 - Go to the bar and restaurant.

A VALID HEALTH PASS MUST FILL ONE of the following 3 elements:

1. AN ATTESTATION that you have been fully-vaccinated

With a vaccine recognised by the European Medicines Agency:

- A period of 7 DAYS must be respected after your second injection for vaccines requiring two doses.
- OR 4 weeks after your injection for single-dose vaccines.
- OR 1 week after 1 injection in people with a history of Covid.

NB. If the delay is shorter, a test is required.

2. A NEGATIVE result for a PCR or antigen test taken within the previous 72 hours

- Tests are not possible onsite. Only in a Pharmacy, laboratory or test centre in France or abroad.
- The presence of a QR Code on the result is not mandatory.
- Self-tests sold in pharmacies or on the internet are not valid.
- The validity is 72 hours (24 hours at the borders -> the same test is therefore valid if you come directly).

3. A positive result to a RT-PCR test proving that you have recovered from Covid-19

- Dated at least 12 days but less than 6 months.
- As of 10 July 2021, a positive antigen test is no longer valid.
